

Houseplant Vacation at the Hammer Museum July 31 - August 28, 2010

Information:

- You must drop off your plant/s on July 31 from 11am-6pm and pick up your plant/s on August 28, 2010 between 11am - 6pm. No exceptions!
- Our resident plant expert will tend to your plant's physical needs once a week. Our resident guest artists will tend to your plant's emotional needs and imagination every Saturday between 1-4pm.
- You are welcome to visit your plant/s during regular museum hours and for the performances/forums/discussions on Saturdays. However, you may not bring your plant/s any outside material including: water, food, fertilizer etc...

Release Waiver:

I hereby certify that I am the sole provider and responsible party for this plant/s and promise my plant/s will comply with all applicable Hammer or building policies, rules and regulations.

I will not hold the Hammer responsible if my plant/s gets sick, is overserved, pollinates another plant, disappears in plant napping or otherwise, or if my plant/s enters into any other oral or written contracts while on Houseplant Vacation.

I understand that other plants will be on the Houseplant Vacation and that during the course of participation my plant/s may come into direct contact with all other participating plants and thusly be exposed to infectious diseases. I authorize the Hammer's resident plant expert to administer emergency medical attention to my plant/s.

I hereby give the Hammer authority to expose my plant/s to music, poetry, discussions, and other types of performances with the possibility that the art experienced will impact and illuminate their life, therefore returning to me as a different or changed plant/s

I hereby grant the Hammer the right to document by photography, audio, video, film, and/or other media my plant/s and my plant's adventures on Houseplant Vacation. I grant the Hammer the right to use these recordings of my plant/s likeness, as well as the right to use any biographical, photographic, or other information my plant/s provides the Hammer, for Hammer's educational, exhibition, promotional, fundraising, archival and other nonprofit purposes and uses.

I understand that due to the possible epic nature of this Houseplant Vacation, the Hammer shall own all right, title, and interest to commission, produce, or license a musical or any other dramatized account of my plant's experience while on Houseplant Vacation.

I understand that I release all claims to my plant and it becomes sole custody to the Hammer Museum to employ or release into the wild as they see appropriate if I do not come pick up my plant on August 28, 2010.
