(13) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on July 12, 1939 in the District Court of The United States at Los Angeles, Calif. (14) It is my intention in good faith to become a

citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, State, or sovereignty of whom or which at this time I am a subject or citizen, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States. (15) I am not, and have not been for the period of at least 10 years immediately preceding the date of this petition, an anarchist; nor a believer in the unlawful damage, injury, or destruction of property, or sabotage; nor a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government; nor a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposition to organized government. (16) I am able to speak the English language (unless physically unable to do so). (17) I am, and have been during all of the periods required by law, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. (18) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since 2-26-1939

and continuously in the State in which this petition is made for the term of 6 months at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since March 20, 1939 (19) I have not heretofore made petition for naturalization: No. on at in the Court, and such petition was dismissed or denied by that Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:

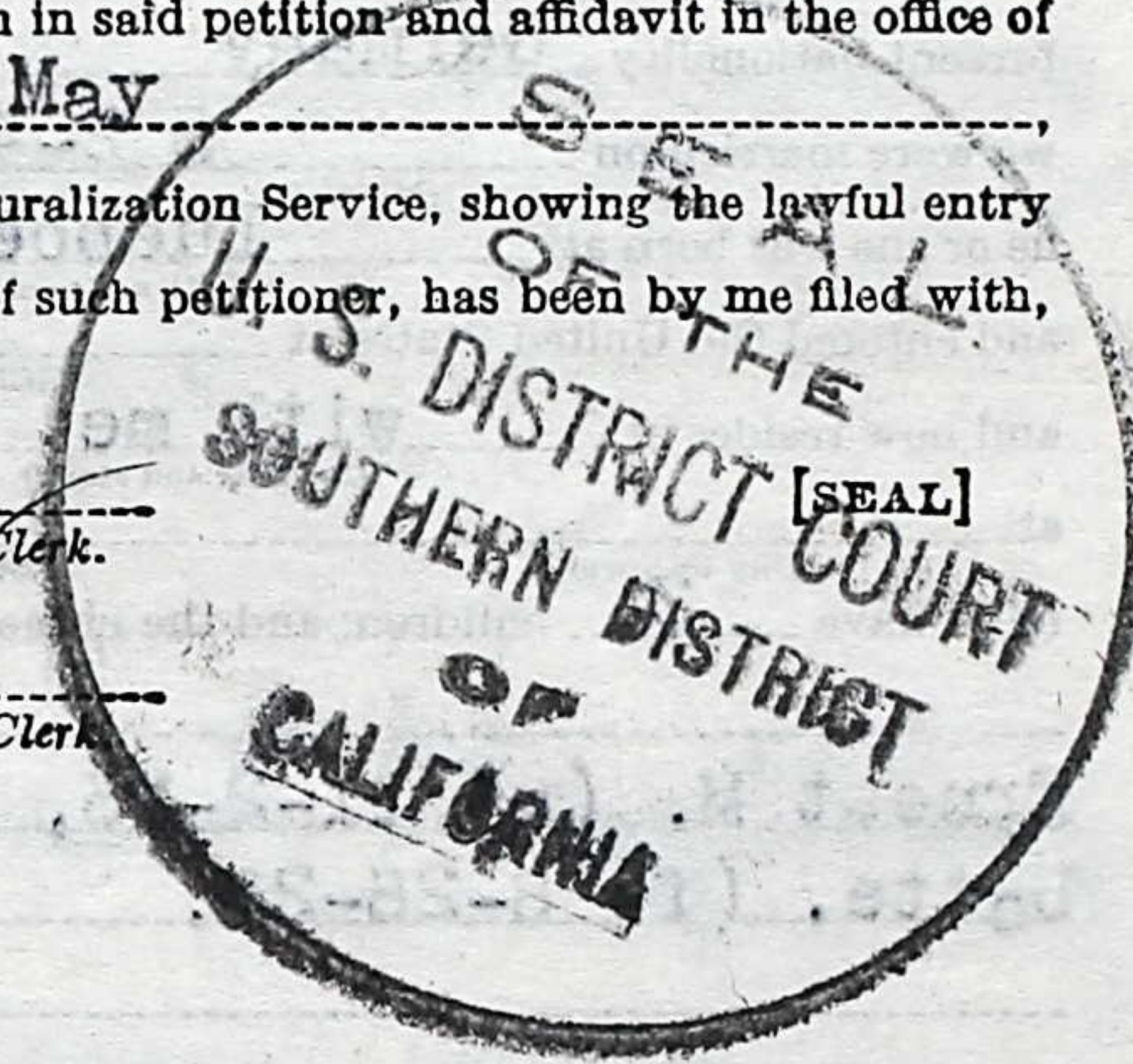
